ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2020-11

9 On November 10, 2020, Nevada Governor Steve Sisolak issued a new directive
10 during a press conference, requesting that citizens in the State of Nevada work from home
11 whenever possible, and continue to wear masks in public and socially distance due to a
12 recent surge in Covid-19 cases in Nevada. Additionally, Nye County has experienced a
13 recent surge of Covid-19 cases as well, causing Nye County hospitals to fill dangerously
14 close to capacity. Accordingly, the Pahrump Justice Court hereby issues the following
15 changes to its previous Covid-19 Administrative Orders, effective November 19, 2020:

- 16 1. The Court will conduct civil and criminal hearings by telephonic or video
17 appearance only until otherwise ordered. Self-represented litigants will be
18 contacted directly by court staff to receive information on how to appear by
19 phone or video. Counsel for represented parties shall be responsible for
20 providing their clients with information on how to appear by phone or video.
21 Court staff will contact attorneys to provide information on virtual appearances,
22 but will not contact any represented litigants to provide such information.
 - 23 a. Any evidentiary hearings, such as preliminary hearings, bench trials, and
24 revocation hearings, where testimony and admission of evidence will be
25 presented, shall be conducted by video appearance only. **All parties or**

1 sanitizer immediately prior to having contact with Court staff. Court staff will not
2 assist any individuals who fail to comply with this requirement.

- 3 5. Any persons showing symptoms of Covid-19, as defined by the CDC, are
4 prohibited from entering the Pahrump Justice Court and shall contact the court
5 via phone or email to reschedule their hearing, or to obtain assistance on any
6 other matters.

7 All other provisions set forth in the Court's previous Covid-19 Administrative
8 Orders, which are not expressly modified or vacated by this Order, shall remain in effect
9 until further notice. This Administrative Order is posted on the Nye County website and
10 copies may be obtained by emailing the Court at pic@pahrumppjusticecourt.com, or by
11 contacting the court at (775) 751-7050.
